YUSUF H. IŞIK

Yusuf H. Işık completed his high school education at Brussels European School, received his B. Sc in economics from London School of Economics, Master's degree in the same field from the University of Birmingham. He was Head of the Strategic Research Department at the State Planning Organisation (SPO) of Turkey between 1998-99. He was lecturer at METU between 1995-2000. He worked as vice-chairman of OECD's Employment and Social Affairs Committee in1996, In 2002 he was advisor to the minister of economy. He worked at SPO-Ministry of development between 2007-2011. Since 2011 he works as economy advisor.

His research and publication areas mainly include macroeconomic and social policies, the knowledge economy, development, corporate governance.



DR. O. CEVDET AKÇAY

O.Cevdet Akçay completed his high school education at Robert College, received his B.A. in economics from Boğaziçi University, and his M.Phil. and Ph.D. from Graduate School and University Center at City University of New York. He served at Boğaziçi University as Asst. Prof. and as Assoc. Prof. between 1992-2001, and was full-time faculty member at Koç University between 2001-2009. He worked as Chief Economist at Koç Financial Services and Yapi Kredi until May 2018. He currently functions as a freelance economist providing consultancy mostly for foreign banks and their clients regarding their Turkey portfolios as well as for some state institutions, the Ministry of Finance and Treasury most currently.

His research and publication areas mainly include exchange rate determination, debt dynamics, and disinflation with specific emphasis on the Turkish experience in these fields.
