PROF. DR. OĞUZ IŞIK

He completed his undergraduate studies in 1982 and his master's degree in 1984 at the Department of City and Regional Planning at the Middle East Technical University, and his PhD in 1991 at the University College London. Until 2019, Işık served as a faculty member at the Department of City and Regional Planning, Middle East Technical University. He works on demography, urbanization, poverty, political geography and inequality. PROF. DR. ÜMİT ÖZLALE

Professor Ümit Özlale has been serving as the head of Department of Economics and academic director of the MBA programs in Özyeğin University since 2013. After finishing his PhD in Boston College, Ümit Özlale started his academic career in Bilkent University, Department of Economics. He continued his career in TOBB University of Economics and Technology, where he served as the head of Department of International Entrepreneurship and advisor to the Rector's Office on Academic affairs and research projects. During that period, he also served as the director of Training and Research Institute of Public Policy within TEPAV. Ümit Özlale's main research fields are applied macroeconomics, economic policy and Turkish economy. Since 2003, he worked as an advisor to the Central Bank of Republic of Turkey, the ministry of Finance and as an executive board member for innovation and Entrepreneurship Support Programs in Tübitak. He also served as senior key expert in various World Bank projects and an executive committee member of European Association of Development Research Institutes (EADI). In 2012, Professor Özlale has been awarded with "The Young Investigator Award" by Tübitak, which has been given to outstanding academicians under 40 years old.

She completed her undergraduate studies in 2001 and her master's degree in 2005 at Marmara University, Economics Department. She worked as Economist in 2004 and as Chief Economist between 2012-2016 at Garanti Yatırım.
